NCR Country Club was designed by the late Dick Wilson and opened in 1954. The Club has two distinctively different 18-hole courses, the North and the South. The North Course is a prairie-links style with a par of 70 and a total yardage of 6,828. The club is currently preparing for a major course restoration that could begin as early as 2023. The South Course a par 71 covering 7,048 yards of heavily-wooded and rolling countryside, has long been included in Golfweek “Top 100 Classic”. The South Course has hosted the 2013 Women's State Team Championship, 2005 U.S. Senior Open, 1998 U.S. Mid-Amateur, 1986 U.S. Women's Open, and the 1969 PGA Championship. NCR Country Club has two player development areas: The first one is a 6 acre short game practice facility with 5 target greens, 3 acres of fairway and bunkers to develop any shot in the game. The second practice facility includes 8,000 square foot player development center with six trackman simulators and putting surfaces. It is currently under construction and schedule to open in early 2022.
